Janet Stecher and Susan Lewis are the singing duo Rebel Voices. Their provocative repertoire combines political punch and wry wit with intricate harmony and dramatic flair. This powerful and inspiring duo promises an evening of thought provoking, zany, reaffirming music to lift the spirit and prick the conscience.

Janet and Susan have been singing together for over 20 years. As members of the women's trio *Belles of Hoboken* in the early 80s, they performed throughout the New York City area and recorded numerous songs for the "Fast Folk" musician's cooperative monthly musical "magazine." Then, they moved to Seattle, where they were founding members of *Shays' Rebellion*, a quartet whose 'songs of social movements past and present' have been heard across the United States and Canada.

Since 1989, Janet and Susan have been performing and recording as the duet **Rebel Voices**. They have appeared in concert at coffehouses, K-12 schoolrooms,

colleges, festivals, living rooms, conventions, rallies, picket lines, and union halls across the U.S. and Canada, and as far away as England and Portugal.
